

DAQreporter Privacy Statement

In the course of doing business with Antek Healthware, LLC and/or through the www.mednexus.net and daqreporter.com portal, you or your clients/patients/customers may share private information with us. Patient Information that constitutes “Private health Information” as that term is defined in the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), Public Law 104-191, as amended, is referred to as “PHI.” We treat your information and PHI as confidential and recognize our legal obligations to protect such information from unauthorized access in accordance with applicable law. Access to sensitive information, including medical practice information and PHI, is controlled by the practice. Patient and practice specific information is never shared with third parties, unless authorized in writing by the practice, required to be disclosed by subpoena or other legal process, or as provided below under the section “Use of PHI”. Our information security policies comply, and will comply in the future, in all material respects with requirements of applicable law.

We collect the e-mail addresses of those who communicate with us via e-mail and information volunteered by the consumer, such as site registration data. Internet Protocol (IP) addresses and other information created or used by a web server interacting with a browser client are used during sessions, but this information is not saved after the particular user session expires, provided that Cookies (small text files stored on your computer by operation of your internet browser) may be used to store visitor preferences and record session information and survive the termination of user sessions.

Information we collect is also used for internal review, used to improve the content of our site, used to customize the content and/or layout of our site for each individual visitor, but is not shared with other organizations unless we are compelled by applicable law to so, such as in the case where we are subpoenaed, or we are advised by our legal advisors that failure to make a disclosure under law would result in our own violation of an applicable law, rule, regulation or other order.

Use of PHI. We shall not use or disclose PHI except:

- (1) As specifically required or permitted by applicable law or regulation, or for law enforcement purposes;
- (2) To the extent required or permitted by subpoena, court order, or other judicial or administrative proceedings, including workers' compensation programs;
- (3) As expressly permitted in writing by You, the Patient's Provider or the Patient to whom such Personal Information refers or relates;
- (4) Solely as necessary to effect, administer, service, process or enforce a transaction, product or service You requested or authorized;

(5) As permitted under the agreement between Us and You relating to Your access and use of the web site portals, such as disclosing Personal Information to You, a Patient and/or such Patient's Carrier or Provider; and

(6) Otherwise solely to operate and provide the services associated with DAQreporter.

Upon request we offer visitors the ability to have inaccuracies corrected in contact information. We will use reasonable efforts to correct such information, in a reasonable time.

We use generally available industry-standard encryption technologies when receiving and sending data that is exchanged with our site. When we transfer and receive certain types of sensitive information, including PHI, we redirect visitors to a secure server. We have reasonable and appropriate security measures in place in our physical facilities to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of information that we have collected from you at our site.
